During the beautiful Easter Vigil liturgy there was (and always is) a lull between the extended Liturgy of the Word (Old Testament readings) and the return of the Gloria, Alleluia's and instrumental accompaniment that begins the "celebration" of Christ's Resurrection and reality of his glorified existence for all eternity. It might also be the case in our faith lives that there is a lull between our celebration of our baptismal status (which we renewed at the Easter Vigil) and our lives going forward beyond the Octave of Easter and even the Easter Season, to the rest of the "Church Year". In fact the Easter Season (which culminates with the Solemnity of Pentecost the coming of the Holy Spirit) is given for us to pay attention to the growth of the Church in the years following the Resurrection which among other things renews our evangelical zeal to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ crucified and risen to others explicitly (especially to those who are unchurched and/or are not practicing their faith) and implicitly by our service-filled, hope-filled and peacefilled lives in the Lord.
